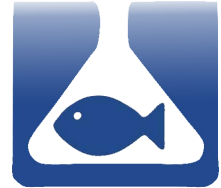


Parasite-S



Authorization to Ship PARASITE-S in Cold Weather

PARASITE-S (fisheries grade formalin) should not be allowed to reach temperatures below 40 degrees F. Shipping during cold weather (especially when night time temperatures are below 40°F) may result in damage to the product.

Regional weather conditions vary greatly and Syndel advises that all formalin users arrange for product shipping prior to the cold weather season. Syndel makes no guarantees, expressed or otherwise, that temperature-sensitive PARASITE-S can safely be shipped in cold weather. It is up to the customer to determine if their local weather conditions are appropriate for shipping of PARASITE-S.

Some items to consider when requesting shipping of Parasite-S in cold weather:

- Depending on the final destination, Parasite S can ship from locations in Washington state, Oregon, California, or Alabama.
- Whenever possible, arrange shipping for early in the week to allow delivery before the weekend.
- An insulated cover protection program can sometimes be arranged for an additional fee. Please inquire if this is available in your area.
- Heated shipping vans can sometimes be arranged for an additional fee. Please inquire if this is available in your area.
- Customers requesting shipping of PARASITE-S during cold weather will be asked to complete and sign this form below.

Syndel makes no guarantees, expressed or otherwise, that temperature-sensitive PARASITE-S can safely be shipped in cold weather. By signing this form, you agree to take any and all responsibility for shipment of said PARASITE-S during the cold weather season. Also, if you request shipment during the cold weather season, you agree to take responsibility for all monies due, regardless of the condition of the delivered PARASITE-S.
